KEY DECISIONS OF COUNCIL - February 2019

- That Council resolved to approve an amendment to the Tasman Interim Planning Scheme 2015 and include a bushfire prone areas overlay;
- a) That the report of the Building & Development Services Manager be received and that;
- b) Pursuant to section 34(1) (b) of the former provisions of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993, Council resolve to initiate Amendment AM 1/2019 to the Tasman Interim Planning Scheme 2015;
- c) Pursuant to section 35 of the former provisions of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993, Council certify that Amendment AM 1/2019 to the Tasman Interim Planning Scheme 2015 meets the requirements of section 32 of the former provisions of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993 and authorise the General Manager to sign the Instrument of Certification attached to this Agenda;
- d) Pursuant to section 56S of the Water and Sewer Industry Act 2008, Council refers Amendment AM 1-2019 to TasWater; and
- e) Pursuant to section 38 of the former provisions of the Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993, Council place Amendment AM 1/2019 to the Tasman Interim Planning Scheme 2015 on public exhibition for a period of at least 28 days following certification.
- That Council resolved to contact the Department of State Growth and request the speed limit for Blowhole Road, from the intersection with the Arthur Highway through to the Doo Town sign be reduced from 60km/hr to 50km/hr.
- That Council resolves to waive all planning, building and plumbing permit application fees for the reconstruction of a dwelling at 48 Duck Creek Road, Murdunna that was destroyed by the January 2013 bushfires.
- That Council resolves to review and adopt the following policies:
 - o Policy C016 – Councillors Expenses & Facilities
 - o Policy NEW – Communication Devices & Social Media
- That Council adopt the 2018-19 Mid-Year Budget Review.
- That the Council approve the Acting General Manager to engage the existing three (3) Audit Panel Independent Members for a further 12 months.

WORKS REPORT

Unsealed road maintenance and re-sheeting has been undertaken on Hylands Road, Murdunna boat ramp, Flinders Bay Road, Bay View Street, Hawker Street, Newman's Creek, George Street and Palmers Lookout.

At this time of the year we struggle to keep up with the maintenance because of excessive traffic, excessive speed and the roads have also dried out considerably. These conditions cause the unsealed network to corrugate and rut significantly.

The council do regularly inspect the conditions and will put reduced speed signs on certain areas allowing the depot time to rectify the problems. We always advise drivers to drive to the conditions not 80km as the recommended speed limit for unsealed roads.

Waterfall Bay Road to be sealed sometime during the week starting 25 February 2019. Road rehabilitation and gravel road conversion to start next week. Stormlea Road Drains and prep work has started, and reseal at Olsens Road completed.

Other drainage works include George Street, Pirates Road, Blowhole Road, Main Road Nubeena, Parsons Bay and Hylands Road (ongoing).
